Geography Bright Lights, Big City This project teaches children about the physical and human characteristics of the United Kingdom, including a detailed exploration of the characteristics and features of the capital city, London. Music Dynamics - Children make links between music, sounds and environments and use percussion, vocal and body sounds to represent calm or stormy seas.
