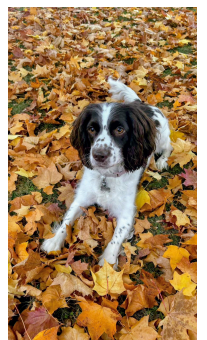
The team will be going through the next round after half term. We look forward to hearing the next outcome!
